



Minutes from the General Membership Meeting of the BHS Athletic Boosters Club

Vice President Deacon welcomed the Booster Members who attended and thanked them for their support of BHS athletics.

Treasurer's Report: Margaret Perkey reported a current balance of \$16,105.07 and a balance in the "Track Fund" of \$6,906.27. Recent expenses of \$14,308.55 have been paid and the August /September income was \$14,706.27. In addition, fall program printing is estimated at \$2,500.00. She also reported a donation was being made to the Martin Scholarship Fund on behalf of Boolie Martin in the amount of \$250 by BHS Athletic Boosters.

Membership: Cindy Tyree reported that the General Membership stands at 57 members. The Membership needs to grow and challenged everyone to continue soliciting for new members.

Publicity: Julie Regan reported that response to signage posted during school registration was very positive in letting people know what projects the Boosters have paid for. The Boosters will continue to display the list of achievements.

Concessions/Souvenirs: Darlene Kidd reported that concession to date for Volleyball have totaled over \$1,100.00. The Bee Barn sales have been down. Hopefully with cold weather coming the sale of clothing will pick up. Boosters will also do a better job of continuing sales during Basketball and Wrestling. In addition to that, Boosters will be open for business during the holidays so people can purchase BHS related items for Xmas gifts. The dates and times will be announced at a later date.

Mr Whorley reported that the Amherst/Brookville football game attendance and ticket sales was the highest ever while he has been principal and that record was broken at the JF/Brookville football game (Homecoming). He thanked everyone for their continued support. The Paul Brewer Classic Golf Tourney will be at Ivy Hill on Saturday May 10, 2008 at 8:00AM. Details will follow after the first of the year. The New Turf on the football/soccer field has held up very well and thanked the Booster Club for their contribution to the renovation project. New projects the Booster club is

considering include permanent ticket buildings at both ends of the field and a winter cover for the field.

Mr. Vasvary reported on a successful Fall Sports program to date. The Golf Team won the Seminole District Tourney and sent 3 players to Regionals, the Football team is 5-3 and should qualify for Regional play in November. Regional seedings have yet to be determined, The Volleyball team is well on their way to another District Title and it was mentioned that the team has not lost a district game in over 4 years, Cross Country is having a great season and the District Meet is the Week of October 22nd, Performance Team will compete this weekend in Districts, and the Marching Band continues to earn high honors at their respective band competitions. Winter sports are about a month away. He also mentioned BHS will host the Girls Varsity Basketball Tournament semi finals and final in February 2008.

Fundraisers: Boosters continue to look for new fundraising opportunities and are considering hosting volleyball and basketball AAU tournaments in the Spring of 2008.
