## SUPPORT CAMPBELL COUNTY EDUCATION

Campbell County schools have lost over 12 million dollars in state revenue since 2008. We have eliminated 129 full-time positions and closed two schools. Further cuts could be catastrophic! We are asking that students and parents come out on May 15th showing their school spirit by wearing Brookville attire. We need our schools to be fully funded. There are no more cuts to make. After the rally, we will caravan down to Rustburg High School to the Board of Supervisor's Public Hearing at 5:30 p.m. Please come out and show your support!

## News from the School Nurse

**T**he end of the school year is in sight and so it is time for those "policy" reminders! **Parents must pick up any remaining medications by the last day of school,** otherwise items will be destroyed. This includes over the counter and prescription medications. Students with signed IHCP's may pick up and transport inhalers, epipens and diabetic supplies on the last day of school. **Individual Health Care Plans are renewed at the beginning of EACH SCHOOL YEAR.** Some medical practices charge additional fees if the form is not brought to the appointment

time for completion. The forms are available online and at the school for you to get prior to summer time appointments.
